## Receives AB Degree

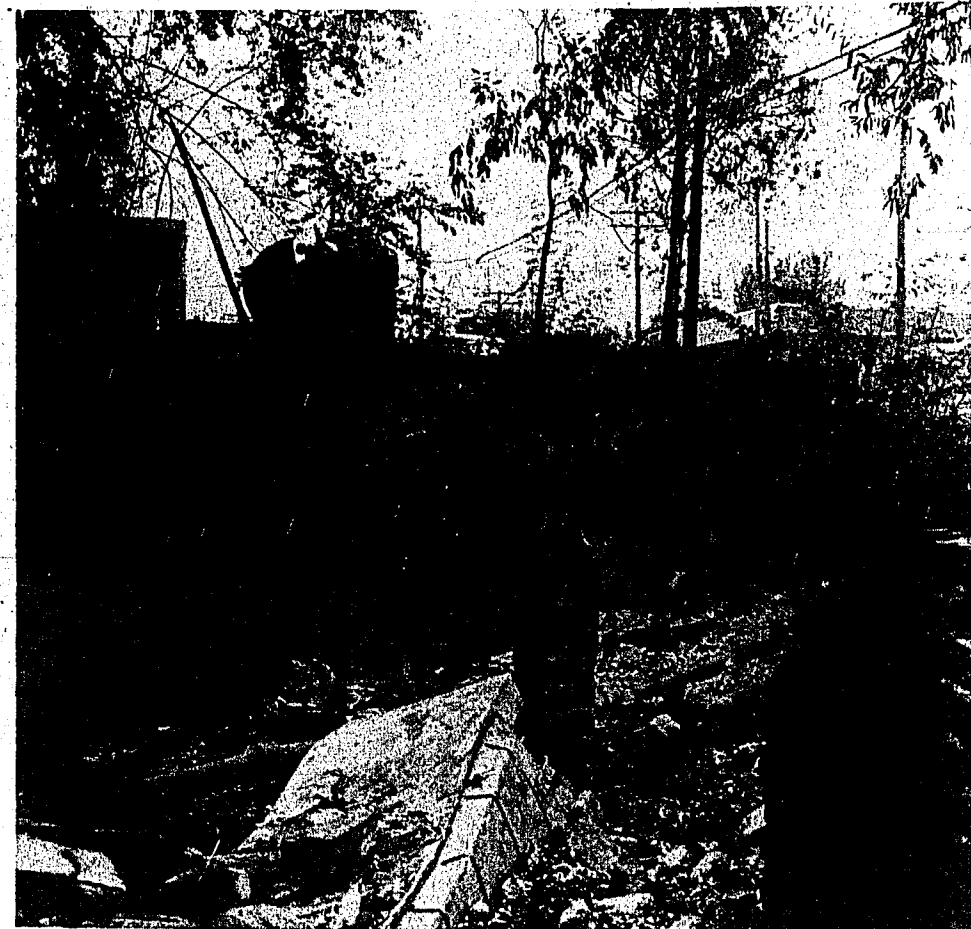
