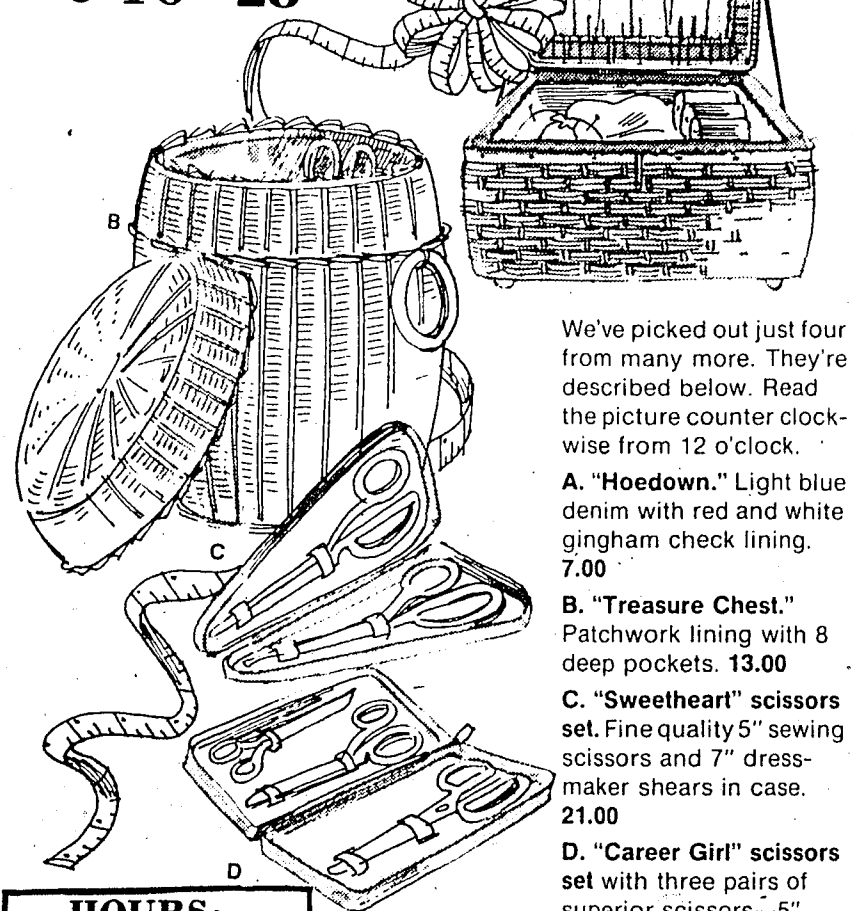

sandwiches of ham and cheese, minis, nuts, and cheese straws were served with banana punch and coffee.

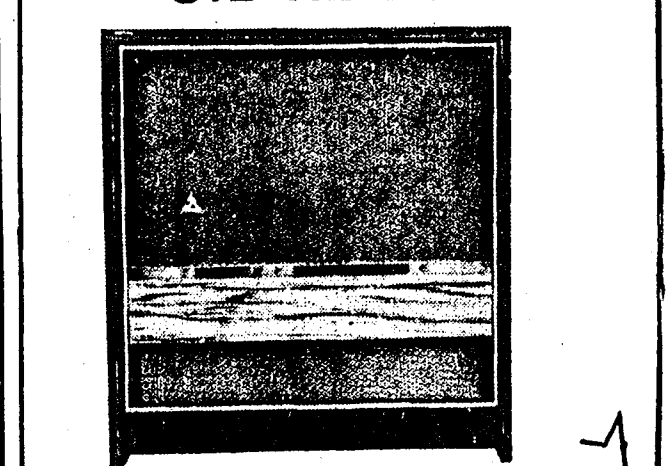
Mrs. Lucy Cook completed the serving of the anniversary cake and Mrs. James A. Wade presided at the punch service.
