For Nice Gain In Win Over West Rowan

## WR Bedeviled By Defense, 35-20

After two quarters of free-wheeling offense by both teams, Mooreville mounted an effective defense here Friday night and turned back West Rowan 35-20. The win gave the Blue Devils a 3-1 season mark, and pushed them to 2-0 in conference play. The loss was their first in the conference for the visiting Falcons.

The Devils accumulated 386 yards in total offense. Quarterback Terrell Rhye connected on two of five attempts for 40 aerial yards, and he contributed 35 yards on the ground. Fullback David Mullis rolled to 153 yards, and runningback Johnny Walker gained 143 yards.

Mullis accounted for two touchdowns on bursts of three yards and 24 yards. Walker and Rhye scored once each, and flanker Jeff Wade snagged a 19-yard pass in the end zone to round out the scoring.

West and Mooreville scored three times each in the first half. West broke the tie with a 19-yard pass to end Mark Allen for 18 yards and the other end Presley Hall.

Mooreville struck first at 10-12. Terrell Rhye pounced on a Falcon fumble. Four plays later, the Devils were on the board. Rhye squirted around end for 18 yards to pick the first Falcon victims. The kick by Mullis was good, as were all five of his PAT boots.

The Falcons scored on a score the next time they got the ball. Hogue and Robbie Gray were the prime movers in the 10-play drive that collected four first downs. Hogue ran in from three yards out, and the

kick tied the score with 5:07 left in the first period.

The locals came back on their next possession. The drive used up seven plays and earned three first downs. Tony Heger made a one-handed stab of a Rhye pass to keep the drive alive. Walker got the call at the three and powered in to score.

The tit-for-tat offensive display continued after the Moore's kicked off. West drove back upfield to again tie the score. The TD came on an Ellis-to-Hall pass. Hall missed the PAT to give the locals the one-point halftime advantage.

The game turned around in the second half. Donald Duff picked off an enemy pass to spark the Devil defense, and Jimmy McIntosh, Brian Duckworth and Tony Heger figured strongly in the effort that held West scoreless.

The Devils didn't manage to score in the third period, but they began a score-producing drive that ended early in the final quarter. Mooreville drove close to the goal, but two holding penalties held the Devils at bay. On a fourth-and-goal situation at the West 19, Rhye threw the scoring strike to Wade. Mullis and Walker gained much of the vital yardage in this drive.

Mooreville's fifth and final TD came with 1:57 to play in the game. Mullis' bulled through the Falcon line and dashed 24 yards to the goal.

The Devils put their two-game North Piedmont Conference winning streak on the line against the Black Knights of North Davidson there Friday night.
