The emphasis is on practical, realistic and strenuous field exercises using the infantry rifle squad and platoon organization as a vehicle to develop these goals.

Local Guard Lights Up South Stokes

Thanks to Mooresville National Guardsmen, South Stokes High School football players and fans are seeing their sport in a new light this fall.

The local unit—Co. A of the Gastonia-based 50th Engineer Battalion—recently completed erecting four metal light poles near the school's athletic field. The public-service project was completed on weekends during the past five months.

A spokesman for Co. A said a dozen men and six pieces of equipment were involved in the work that required 40 manhours and 200 equipment hours.

Sergeant First Class Gene Duckworth, a local electrical contractor, directed the work. Each of the 30-foot poles erected by the Guard weighs 15,000 pounds. Concrete bases for the poles were constructed by the school near Walnut Cove.

In addition to installing new poles for the field, the local weekend engineers moved six wooden poles from the football field and erected them on a soccer field on the campus.
