

# FAC Teams Overcome Elements And Opposition

Football Athletic Conference varsity football teams battled the elements as well as their non-conference opponents Friday night. And the FAC survived on both accounts.

All seven of the teams staged their games as scheduled on a rain-soaked Friday, and they combined to finish with a 4-3 showing as a result.

With those four wins, including one of them via shutout, the FAC raised its overall mark against outside opposition to 11-8 for the three-week-old season, with one more weekend of pre-conference play tabled ahead.

Three of last week's winners did so to remain undefeated on the season, as North Iredell and Wilkes Central, each at 3-0, and South Iredell, at 2-0, stayed perfect to date.

First-time winner West Iredell registered the league's only blank job in recording a win by shutout. Those four teams account for last week's victories, while league losses were endured by Statesville, North Surry, and Forsyth.

This week, all seven teams will be in action for a third straight week, and the final one of pre-FAC tussles.

The lone league member wrapping up non-league play at home is Forsyth, whose Falcons host Starmount.

Elsewhere around the league, North Iredell visits Alexander Central, North Surry travels to Mt. Airy, South Iredell ventures to Central Cabarrus, Statesville heads to Central Davidson, West Iredell embarks to South Rowan, and Wilkes Central tackles host Hibernian.

West Iredell, last season's dream team that enjoyed a perfect regular season, halted a two-game losing skid this time around with a 2-0 victory over the Hibernian. It made the Warriors, now 1-4, the week's biggest winners among FAC victors.

Wilkes Central's Eagles flew high at home Friday, as they rushed by the visitors from South Caldwell, 22-6. That win, the league's second most lopsided verdict of the weekend, increased Wilkes' mark to 3-0, putting it alongside North Iredell as the top performers this season to date.

North Iredell successfully protected its winning streak by defeating the third largest winning margin enjoyed by an FAC member, as the Raiders moved to 3-0 with a 21-6 plunking of guesting East Lincoln.

South Iredell's offense accounted for all the game's scoring, registering a pair of touchdowns and a field goal, as they rushed by the Vikes shot to 2-0 as a result of their 13-2 downing of West Rowan. The win made a winner of South Iredell, the victor of now six straight non-league games in its home debut.

Statesville will be glad to return to the 3A ranks after suffering its third straight loss to a 4A class member. The Greyhounds, second-place finishers in the FAC a year ago, slumped to 0-3 this season following a 14-7 loss administered by visiting Davie County. It was Statesville's second home loss of the season.

North Surry and South Stokes staged the week's most dramatic contest, with the latter holding off the hosting former by a single point, 27-26. The verdict continued an odd-week loss trend for the Greyhounds, who fell to 1-2 as a result.

Forsyth was the league's only team to take care of business away from home last week, and the Falcons paid the price, as homecoming Mt. Airy sided out a 27-7 triumph. The defeat halted a one-game winning streak on the part of the guests, who this week will be the FAC's only member playing at home, doing so with a 1-1 overall record.

With all seven teams engaged in scheduled activity this week, the teams will use this week's games as final preparation prior to entering the all-important conference portion of play the following Friday night.

That week, all West Iredell, who will observe its open date, will help christen the league's third season of intra-circuit action.

All of this week's games also carry 9 p.m. starting times Friday.
