

## Glover Completes Recruit Training

Navy Seaman Recruit Terrence J. Glover, son of Robert W. Glover of Mooresville, route 5, has completed recruit training at the Recruit Training Command, San Diego, Calif.

During Glover's eight-week training cycle, he studied general military subjects designed to prepare him for further academic and on-the-job training in one of the Navy's 85 basic fields.

Glover's studies included seamanship, close order drill, Naval history and first aid.

Having completed the course, Glover is eligible for three hours of college credit in physical education and hygiene.

## Library Dedicated To Indians

Amid solemn ancient rites of the Montana Cheyenne Indians, the University of California, Riverside, dedicated a major library on Indians.

The Rupert Costo Library of the American Indian, a 7,000-volume, 9,000-document collection was blessed in ceremonies heretofore unseen by non-Indians.

In the mid-1950s, Costo and his wife created the American Indian Historical Society and began their campaign to right the historical record regarding American Indians.

Negotiations then began to transfer the library from the society to the university, a process which took a number of years and culminated in the recent ceremonies. At the same time, the

university announced establishment of the Rupert Costo Chair in American Indian History.

The chair is made possible by a gift of \$400,000 from the society, which is based in San Francisco. It reportedly is the first such academic chair in the nation to be funded by Indian people.

The Costos have appeared before state textbook committees to fight for a scholarly representation of history, rather than the presentation of stereotypes of Indians and Indian life that they say were once prevalent.

The Costos have published the Indian Historian, a scholarly journal; the Wassaja, an advocacy journal; and The Weewish Tree, a magazine for children.
