Crackdown On Illegal Activity Hits Area

The only way to make sure crime doesn't pay, the one-liner goes, is to let the government run it. Perhaps. One way to make sure crime does pay is to let the crooks run it and let the government catch the crooks.

Witness last week's report by U.S. Attorney Tom Ashcraft of the Charlotte-based Western District of North Carolina.

He said the dollar value of assets from illegal activity seized by the federal government in his district grew eightfold during the past year. At the start of 1990, Ashcraft reported, \$2 million in property had been confiscated. By early 1991 the value of seized property was \$16.5 million.

Several of the more extravagant properties are on Lake Norman.

"Federal agents, and cooperating state and local officials, are now looking for assets to seize as a normal part of all criminal investigations," Ashcraft said. "Their work is providing not only a deterrent to criminal enterprises but also more funds for law enforcement without an increase in taxes."

Since the formation of the Asset Forfeiture Unit of the U.S. Attorney's Office in April 1989, seizures and forfeitures have increased dramatically. Before April 1989, the federal government seized a few parcels of land and a handful of automobiles

each year in this district. In the two years since then, about 100 parcels of land have been seized in the district, which runs roughly from I-77 to the Tennessee line, and various other parcels have been seized outside the district based on illegal conduct connected to the district. Vehicle and boat seizures have also increased significantly.

This is a partial list of noteworthy assets seized in the Western district in the last two years:

- Westover Shopping Center and Leola's Plaza, Charlotte.
- Building and grounds used by Personal Touch Car Care Center, Charlotte.
- Eight lots adjoining Statesville Avenue between I-77 and I-85, Charlotte.

• House on Lake Norman, 763 Sundown Road, Mooresville.

• Several motor boats, including a 39-foot 1989 Sea Ray worth about \$129,000, mostly Lake Norman.

• Large sums of cash from individuals or at single locations: \$153,000 at Charlotte/Douglas Airport; \$197,000 in Gastonia; \$148,000 in Charlotte; \$387,000 in Burke County.

• Various items of jewelry and gold, including a 2.5 carat diamond ring and a bracelet with the word "ROCK" in rubies, Charlotte.

• Over 60 automobiles including two Porsches and four Mercedes-Benz's, mainly Charlotte.
