Carnivals, circuses, fairs, carnivals, circuses, theatricals and other commercial and charitable uses of a temporary nature shall be allowed in a particular zoning district subject to the issuance of a permit by the Town Board.

3. Change Sections 5.12 and 6.8.2 to read as follows:

Section 5.12 Use of Trailers and Mobile Homes.

"Mobile homes, regardless of any interior or exterior modifications, shall be used for residential purposes only as prescribed by this Ordinance, except where permitted on a temporary basis pursuant to a permit issued by Section 5.6 of this Ordinance or when serving as a mobile home sales lot office."

4. Delete the following paragraph from the first paragraph of Section 10.1:

If any vacancy in the membership shall be filled for the unexpired term of the same member as the initial appointment."

5. Delete the second paragraph of Section 10.1.

6. Add the following as the second paragraph to Section 10.1:

The Board of Adjustment shall contain five (5) regular members and four (4) alternate members. Annually, in the month of July, the Chairman of the Board of Adjustment shall be responsible for appoint-

regular and alternate slots to the Board. There shall, at all times, be at least one regular member on the Board of Adjustment who is a resident of the extrajurisdictional area. Any member may be reappointed to consecutive regular or alternate positions. An attending member while attending any regular or special meeting of the Board of Adjustment and serving in the absence of a regular alternate member shall exercise all of the powers and duties of such absent regular member.

Change Section 10.3 to state:

"The Zoning Administrator shall give public notice of the public hearing by publishing a notice in a newspaper having general circulation in the Mooreville area at least seven (7) days published prior to the hearing. In addition, the ap-
