These meals will be served in all Iredell County and Statesville schools and during the week beginning May 1. A salad bar is available during lunch at all schools, and milk is served with all meals.

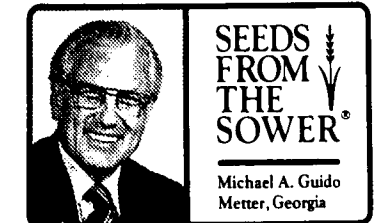
Monday

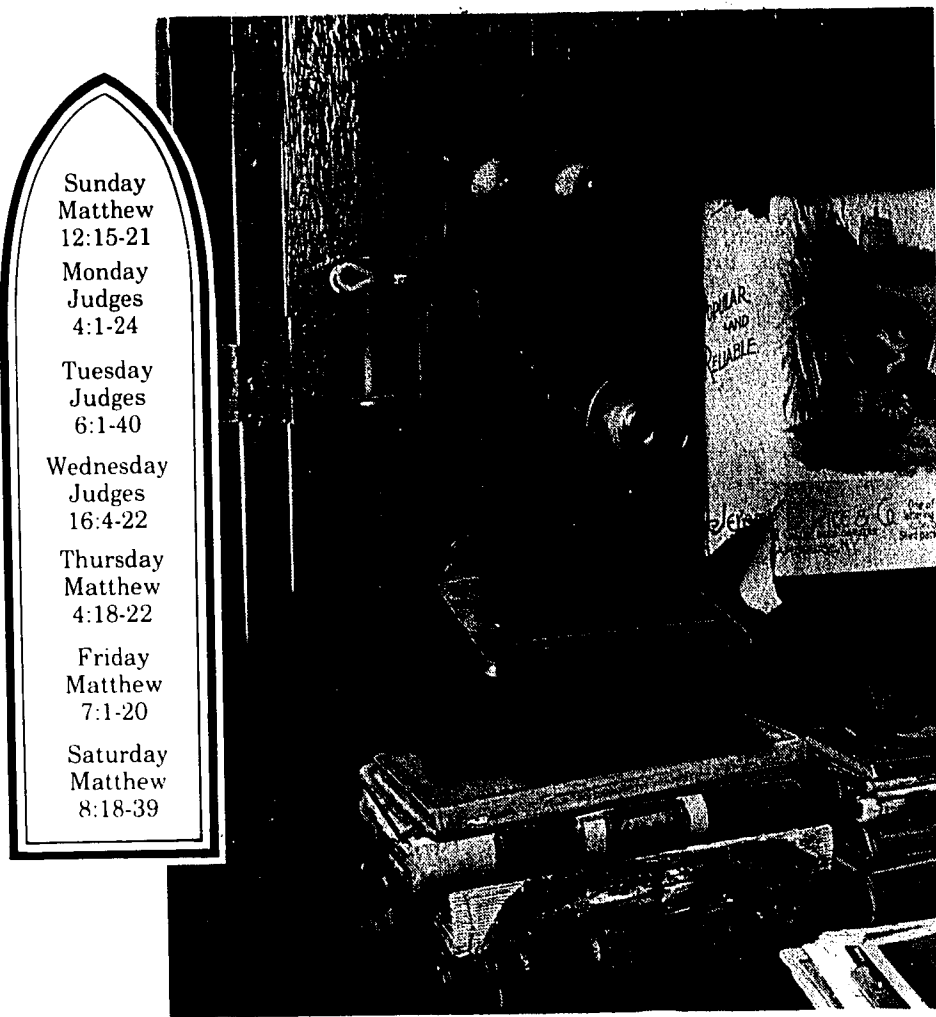

NCANC Duties Take Bost To Central America

Belize City, Belize — About the last place students at China Grove Middle School would expect to see their new assistant principal Don Bost of Mooreville would be in a classroom in Belize. But that is exactly where Bost spent an afternoon recently. Bost, who is a member of the 145th Service Flight, North Carolina Air National Guard based in Charlotte, was in this Central American country as part of a multinational construction project for the Belize Defense Force.

"While I was down here, I wanted to try and visit a school," said the Mooreville resident. "I found their system and ours are really pretty similar." Bost, who taught at China Grove and will become assistant principal when he returns, visited Our Lady of the Way School in Ladyville Village on the outskirts of Belize City. The school has about 450 students in first through eighth grade.

"I was impressed by the discipline of the students," Bost said. "I was there right before a recess and when the principal rang the bell, many students filed orderly out of the rooms, while others stayed in and finished what they were working on."

"There also are no lunch facilities, so the students are dismissed at 11 o'clock, walk home for lunch and then come back for the afternoon," Bost said. "I was amazed the principal said he never had problems with students not coming back."

Another thing that impressed Bost is the apparent degree of parental involvement in the education process.

"There's no school buses, so you see parents walking their children to school and waiting to pick them up," Bost said. "I saw one gentleman carrying his little boy to school every morning on the handlebars of a bicycle and then I would see them peddling home in the afternoon."

The Belizean school year is quite similar to that in the United States. The students go ten months a year and have two months off in the summer.

One major difference in the two educational systems is Belizean students take a test following the eighth grade to see who qualifies to go on to high school.

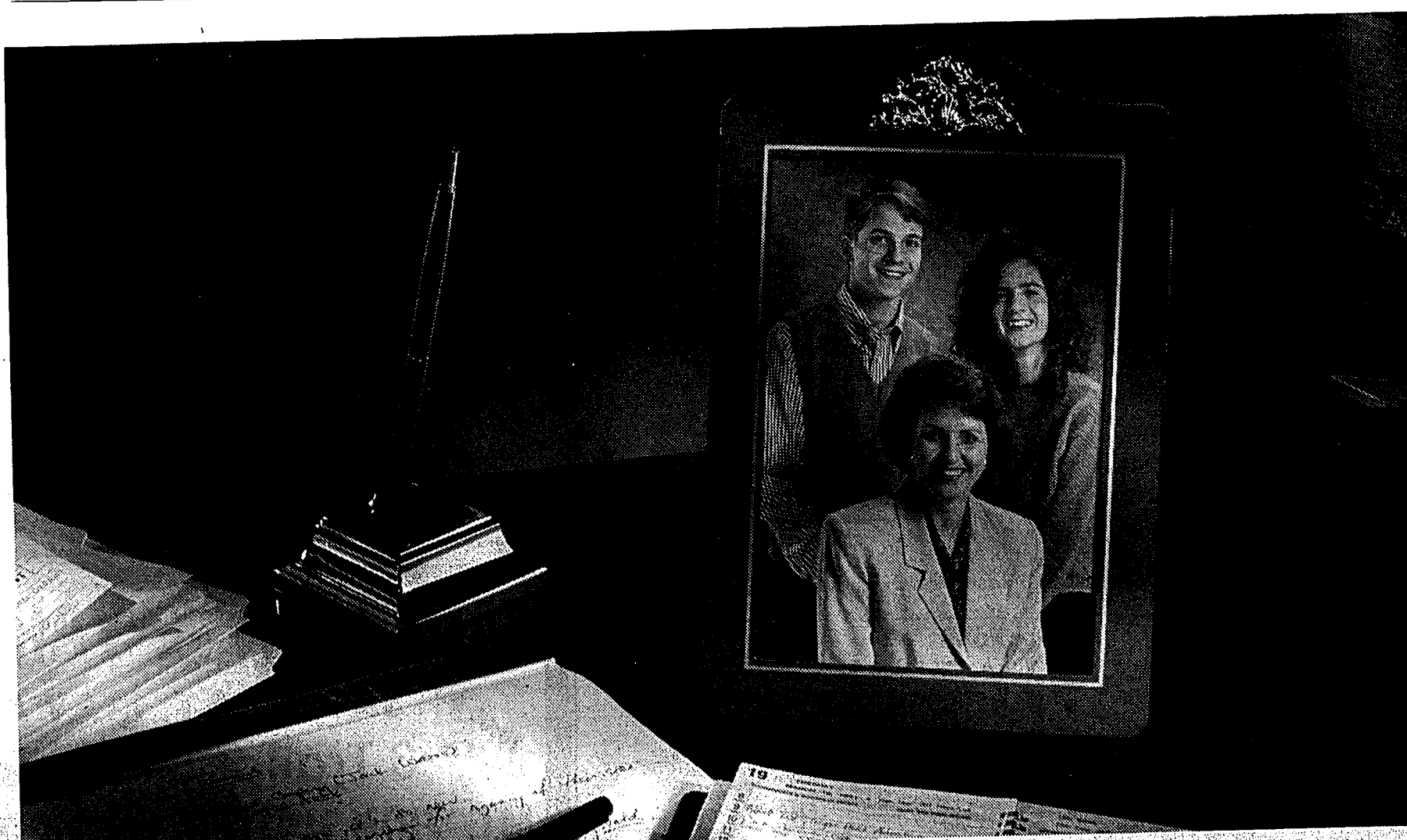
