**CPR Class**  
**May 13-17**

The South Iredell Red Cross will sponsor a Community CPR class May 13-17 from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. at the War Memorial.

This course will teach you:  
1. How to give first aid for choking and other respiratory emergencies;  
2. How to recognize when someone needs CPR;  
3. How to give CPR to someone whose heart has stopped;  
4. How to use the emergency medical services (EMS) system;  
5. How to reduce the risk of dying from a heart attack;  
6. How to recognize the signals of a heart attack and give first aid to reduce the chance that the victim's heart will stop; and  
7. How to reduce the risk of injury to children and infants.

The course fee to be collected at the first class meeting, is \$25 which includes the textbook and certificate.  
This comprehensive course will prepare you to respond to respiratory and cardiac emergencies in adults, children and infants.
