Shepherd VFD since he was 12. He came in as a junior fireman and he became a fireman at 18. He is the department's deputy assistant chief.

Recently, the Iredell County Fireman's Association recognized Robinson as its Fireman of the Year. The award goes each year to the fireman in the county who most clearly demonstrates that he has the right stuff. It is

given for leadership and dedication to duty.

To become eligible for the countywide recognition, a fireman must first be nominated for the award. That Kelly Robinson was Shepherd VFD's nominee shows his standing among his fellow Shepherd firemen.
