Pest Control Violations Cited

Two repeat offenders of the North Carolina Structural Pest Control Law were handed six-month suspended sentences in Winston-Salem recently for a July 1990 violation. Glenn Dale Anderson of Route 5, Mooresville and Richard D. Beckwith of Koroersville were convicted in Forsyth County District Court for an illegal powder post beetle treatment in Winston-Salem. Neither man had a pest control license.

"People cannot treat properties commercially for structural pests without having a North Carolina license," state Agriculture Commissioner Jim Graham said. "We want to insure that pest control workers are properly licensed and trained, and that customers are protected from unscrupulous and unprofessional work."

Judge Roland H. Hayes placed both men under three years' unsupervised probation and or-

dered them not to engage in pest control work without a valid state license. Anderson and Beckwith also have to pay \$180 restitution, \$900 fines and court costs.

They pleaded not guilty to the charge of treating the home of Louise Hamilton of 1918 Kentucky Avenue without a license. Both had been convicted previously in separate cases involving other unlicensed work.

The Structural Pest Control Division, N.C. Department of Agriculture, investigated the incident. The division gathered information and contacted the Forsyth County District Attorney's Office, which prosecuted.

With 11 inspectors statewide, the division oversees operator licensing and enforcement of the N.C. Structural Pest Control Law. It responds to consumer complaints and routinely inspects properties to determine treatment quality. In addition, it enforces regulations pertaining to proper pesticide use in and around properties.

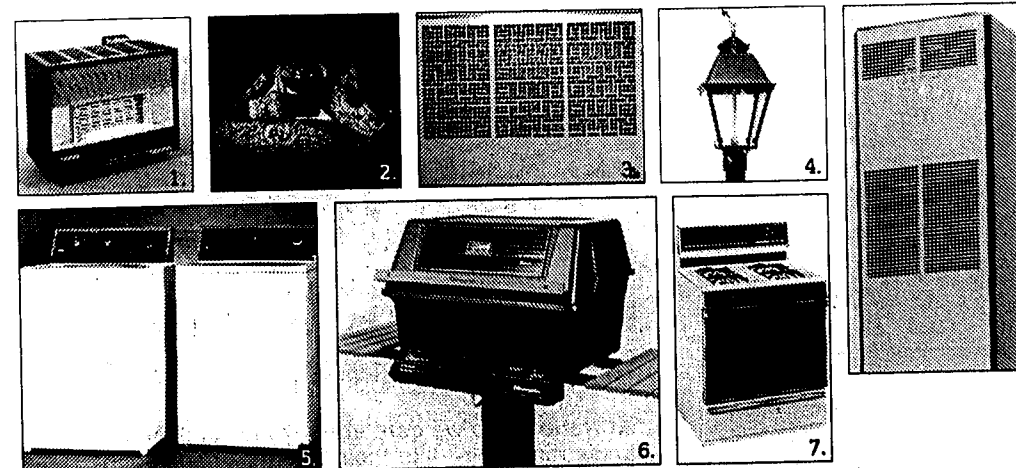
