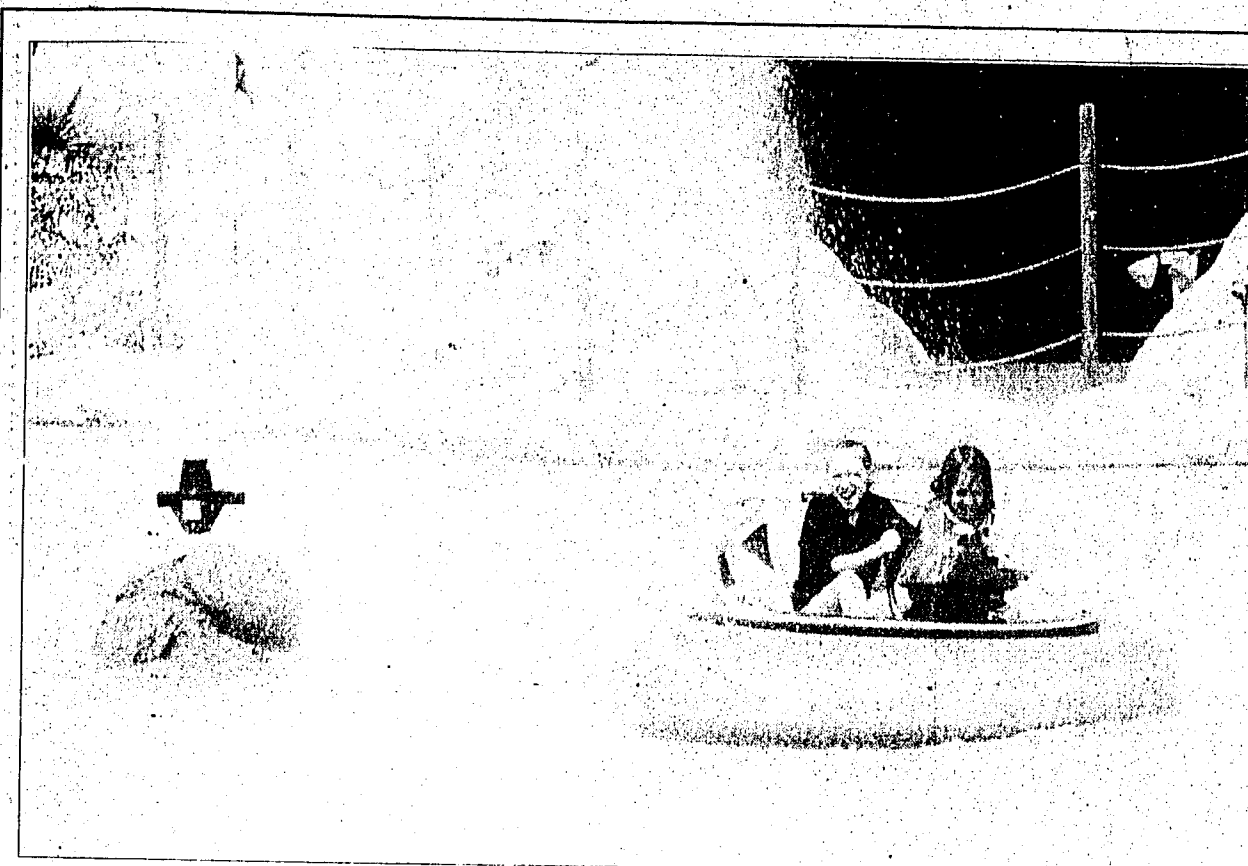

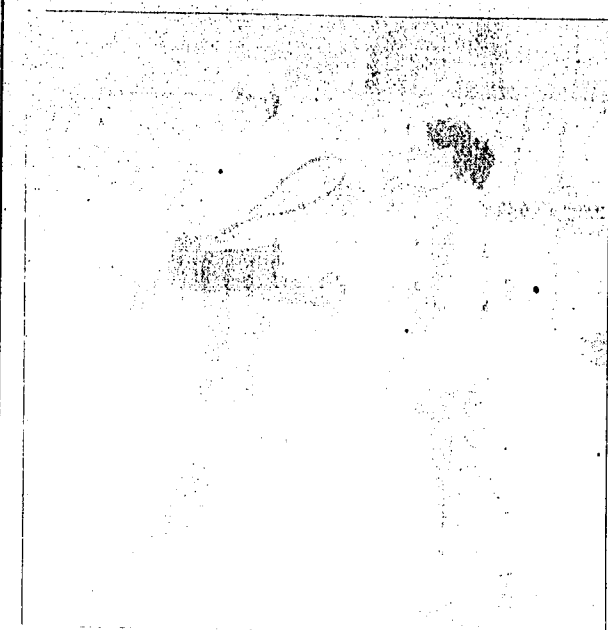

It will be a season of new when the Mooresville girls tennis team opens its season early next week. The only thing the Lady Devils hope gets old fast is winning. The Devilettes open their season at home with a match Tuesday afternoon against non-conference foe Alexander Central. They do so under a new head coach and with new 3A class conference affiliation. Amy Smith, formerly Pardow, herself a product of the school's tennis program, is in her first varsity coaching position in any sport. She was a member of Mooresville's 1997 team that won the conference championship. Smith, recently married to Mooresville's boys head tennis coach Tim Smith, comes on to fill the vacancy left by Tracy Viars, who is now teaching in Texas after relocating there following her husband's work transfer. 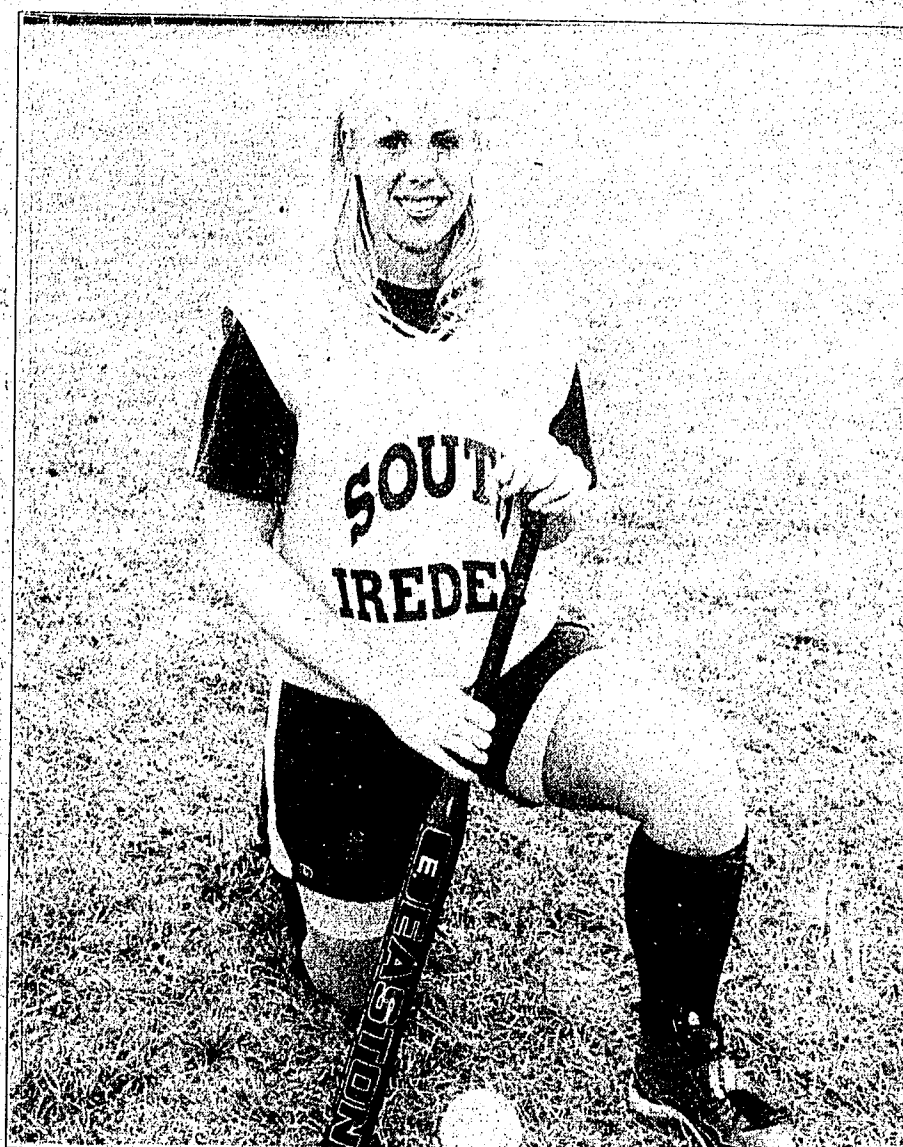
Johnson impressive as Tigers' prospect

Mooresville's Jeremy Johnson keeps setting down opposing batters and opening the eyes of big wheels within the the Detroit Tigers parent professional baseball organization. The former Mooresville Senior High right-handed pitcher did it again in his most recent start for his Oneonta Tigers of the New York-Penn League, tossing six innings of three-hit, one run ball, upping his record to 5-1 overall for a team that used that 10-4 triumph to move just one game over the break-even mark.

The victory by Johnson also helped keep the team in the chase for a possible playoff berth. Johnson, with a fast ball hovering in the high 80s, needed just 88 pitches to complete his six innings of work. He threw 57 strikes, mixing a change-up some nine miles per hour slower - which he feels is still a little too fast - than his fast ball along with a curve that also served to confuse the hitters. He gave up the three hits and one earned run while striking out three.

He continues to impress the organization in just his second full season of minor league baseball, being drafted just over a year ago out of high school by the Tigers. He was also a member of the Mooresville Gresham-Baker Post 66 American Legion pitching staff before entering the game's professional ranks. Used primarily as a starter, Johnson, who has logged 10 starting assignments so far this season, will put his record on the line when making his next start for his Oneonta team later this month.

College-bound

It wasn't a matter of just if recent South Iredell High School graduate Amy Armstrong would continue her softball career into the college ranks. The question was where she would do so. The recruiting subject of a number of programs, Armstrong finally decided on Division III member Greensboro College. She was on track to report to campus situated less than two hours from her Troutman home and then join the rest of the some 200 freshman class members on an orientation trip before starting class later this month.

Tops on her personal agenda is also getting to know fellow members of the school's softball team. Previously the recipient of a couple of local scholarships to help with her tuition costs, Armstrong is also one of just eight incoming freshmen to receive a Greensboro College Deans Scholarship.
