Efforts to revitalize downtown Mooreville have paid off in recent months as several upscale businesses have moved into the central business district.

## Think twice before placing that yard sale sign

If you're holding a yard sale this weekend and are thinking about putting up signs along the road to advertise, you might want to reconsider.

The Mooreville Planning Department has said it will begin stepping up its enforcement of the town ordinance that does not allow commercial signs in the rights-of-way of state and local roads.

Craig Culberson, a planner with the town, said some town commissioners had begun asking about the ordinance's violation, which has prompted the step-up in enforcement.

He also said that some realtors in the area were outside the town's jurisdiction when the ordinance was passed and so may be unaware of it. The step up in enforcement will offer a way to make them aware of it, Culberson said.

The ordinance was last revised in mid-1999, according to Culberson, and forbids the placement of signs in road rights-of-way, except signs regarding government, hospital, and non-profit organizations.

Those signs that cannot be placed along roadways include signs for yard sales, realtors, and subdivisions.

The ordinance also forbids such signs being placed on utility poles. If someone violates the ordinance, a range of penalties can be enforced. First, the town can remove them and issue a warning letter. After that, an offender can be fined \$25 for each illegally posted sign. That fine can increase to \$50 per sign if the behavior continues.

Culberson stressed that signs placed on private property are not forbidden under the ordinance.

## Auditor still hasn't taken schools' case
