WILKES COUNTY FRONTIERSMAN Story Of Burnie Waters Published

The adventures of Burnie Waters, 19th century frontiersman from Wilkes County, are related by Octavia Jordan Perry in a novel, *My Head's High From Proudfess*, published December 6, by John F. Blair, publisher, of Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

From the time he was three and a half years old until he was seventeen, Wilburn Waters was a slave servant. When he took his freedom, he turned to hunting, a calling for which he showed exceptional aptitude. So great was his skill that it inspired exaggeration in the telling of it.

Today, in the area of Southwest Virginia around White Top Mountain where he built his home, the stories told about Burnie Waters have taken on the sheen of legend, and one listens partly to a true account, partly to folk hero worship. The two become more intertwined year by year. Waters himself started the custom; he could tell a story with as much skill as he could trap a wolf or shoot a bear. Often he set the stories to music and, accompanying himself on his banjo, sang the

ballads to his listeners. My Head's High From Proudfess is not a factual account of the deeds of the frontiersman. It was inspired by the scant records of his life and derives from the stories told by Waters, which the author has embellished with dialect, continuity, and romance.

The author was born in Orange County, North Carolina, where her father was a country doctor. Early in her childhood the family moved to Durham. She is a graduate of the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and a past president of the alumnae association.

Mrs. Perry and her husband, a retired businessman, live in High Point and spend the summer months at their home near Sparta, where she first became interested in mountain lore and in the story of Burnie Waters.

TOWNSPEOPLE GIVE \$15,000 TO KEEP INDUSTRY AT HOME

A successful fund drive has assured Kalkaska, Mich., of keeping one of its 2 main industries in operation. But it may have cost the community of 1,300 population its famous National Trout Festival for 1964.

Residents of the town subscribed \$15,000 needed for expansion of Wood Lumber Mill, Inc. The firm was recently purchased by a group with outside interests and would have moved if the fund-raising drive had failed. A spokesman for the Kalkaska Chamber of Commerce said the trout festival had been canceled to meet the drive.

"It would have cost another \$6,000 to hold the festival," he said, "and we don't feel we can go back and ask people to contribute this much more after they've already put up \$15,000." The money will be used to expand operations of the factory, which employs 30 persons.
