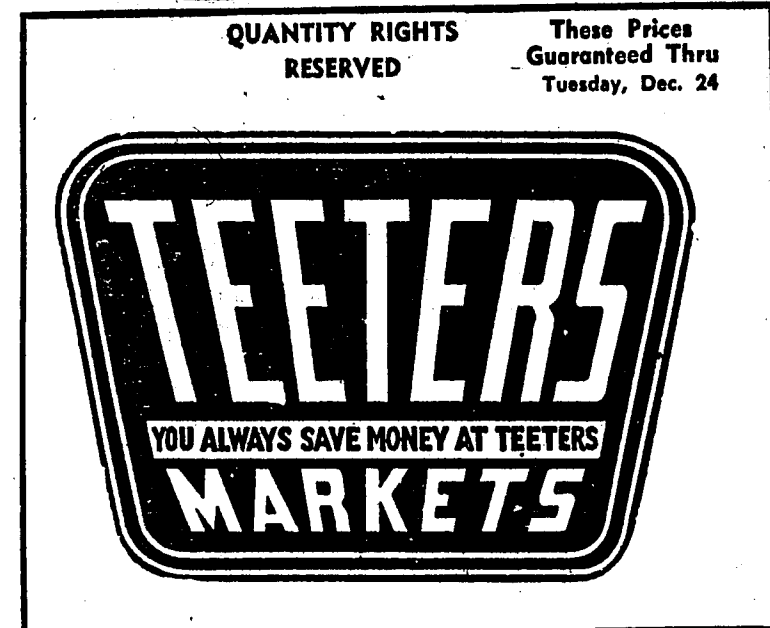

Funeral Rites Conducted For R. L. Martin

Robert Lee Martin, Sr., 71-year-old resident of Weaver Road, Salisbury, route 7, died Friday at 11:05 a. m. at Rowan Memorial Hospital in Salisbury. He had been in declining health since 1958 and seriously ill for 10 days.

Mr. Martin was born on May 19, 1892, in Franklin county, Ga., the son of the late John C. and Eliza Burdette Martin. He was educated in the Franklin County Schools and was employed at the South China Grove Mill until his retirement in 1958. He was a member of the Rice Creek Baptist Church in Franklin county, Ga.

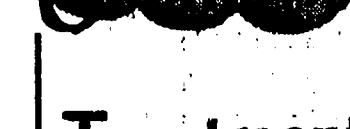
Fraternity Taps Michael Lipe

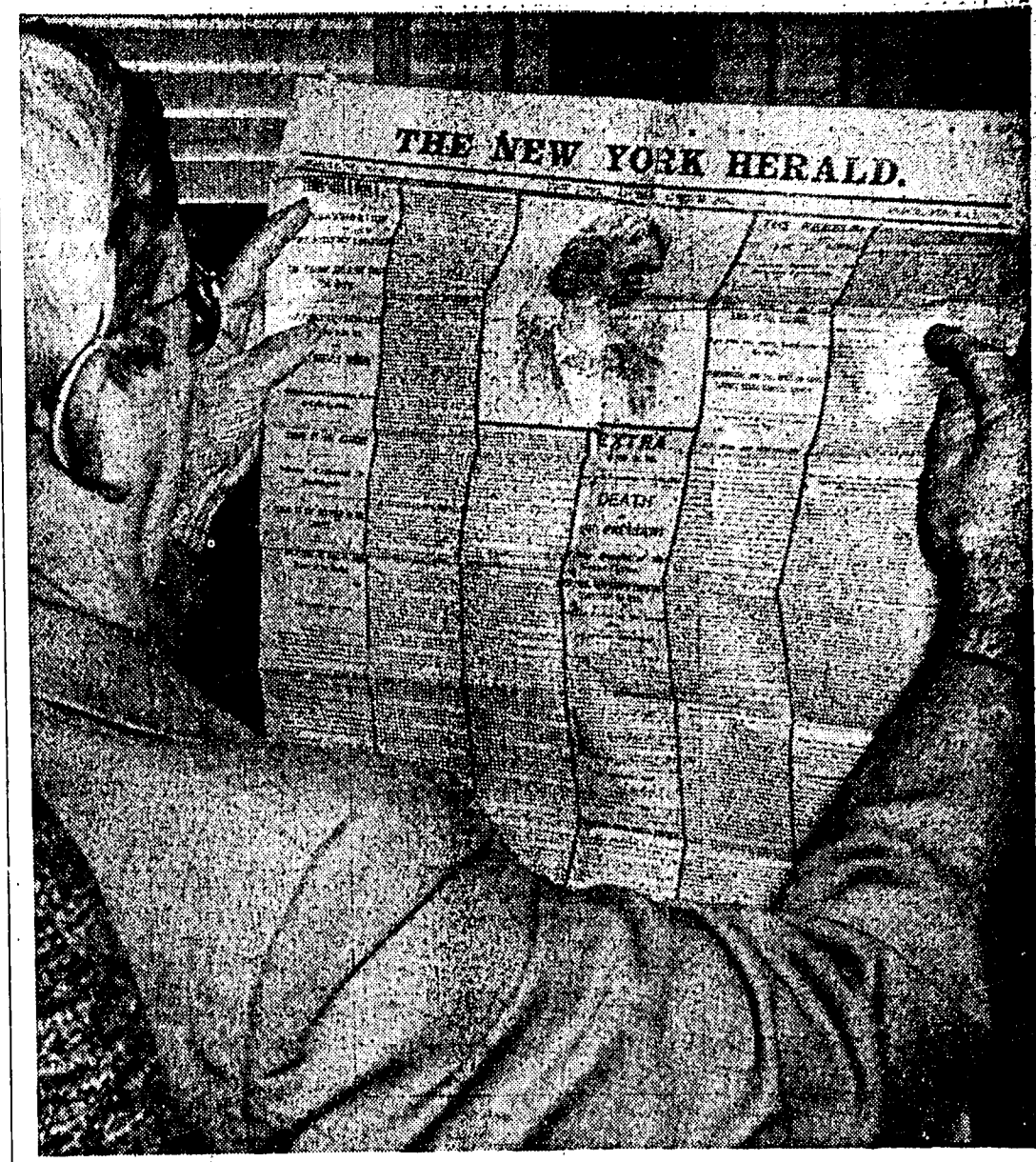

HISTORICAL DOCUMENT — John G. Kennerly, well known Statesville avenue resident, reads of the assassination of President Lincoln as reported in the April 15, 1865, issue of the New York Herald. The paper has been in the Kennerly family ever since its publication 98 years ago, belonging originally to Kennerly's father, the late John A. Kennerly, a veteran of the War Between the States. The newspaper is six columns in width. Four of the six columns of the issue of April 15, 1865, are given over to the assassination. One of the stories of the tragedy has a 10-deck head, while another has a six-deck head. Although the President was not shot until Friday night, April 14, 1865, stories are most complete and, needless to say, make interesting reading today.
