### Lutherans Will Hear Missionary

The Rev. Franklin D. Christliff, missionary to British Guiana, will visit St. Mark's Lutheran Church on Sunday and Monday, January 19 and 20, it was announced this week by the pastor, the Rev. Floyd Trevel.

Speaking each evening at 7 o'clock, Mr. Christliff will present a program concerning the work the denomination is doing in South America.

Mrs. George Setzer, president of the local Lutheran church women is in charge of the two-evening program, and has issued an invitation for the public to attend.

The Rev. Mr. Christliff is on his second furlough from service in British Guiana. Since 1956 he has been a missionary there, sent out by the former United Lutheran Church in America, now Lutheran Church in America. Engaged in evangelistic work, he has carried on his ministry with a strong emphasis on the pastoral aspects, and with considerable attention to developing a sense of stewardship among his parishioners.

He is a graduate of Johns Hopkins University, with a Bachelor of Engineering degree, and of Hamma Divinity School, where he received the B.D. degree in 1956. Between college and seminary he had several years of experience as a mechanical engineer and draftsman. He is originally from Maryland, but worked mainly in Ohio, where he first became active in the church as a layman, and where he was commissioned for overseas service.

The commissioning service was in Grace Lutheran Church, Springfield, Ohio.

Mrs. Christliff was the former Doris Overhall of Springfield, Ohio. The Christliffs have three children. They are making their temporary home in Washington, D.C.

### Forrest Hudson Suffers Fatal Heart Attack

Forrest LeQue Hudson, 52, died at his home in the Prospect community at 6:30 p. m. Monday, although he had suffered from a heart ailment for 18 months, his death was unexpected, being attributed to a heart attack.

A native of Iredell county, Mr. Hudson was born on July 11, 1911, a son of the late John P. and Elizabeth Mower Hudson. He had spent practically all of his life in the Mooreville area, and at the time of his death, was employed by Drymore Manufacturing Corporation.

Mr. Hudson was a member of the Second Presbyterian Church. The survivors include: the widow, Mrs. Jane Alexander Hudson; three brothers, Henry Hudson of Greenville, S. C., Fred Hudson of Mooreville, and Paul Hudson of Richmond, Va.; and two sisters, Mrs. William C. Sprinkle of Mooreville and Mrs. Robert Turner of Charlotte.

Funeral services were conducted at 11 a. m. Wednesday at the Second Presbyterian Church, with the Rev. Wilkes D. Macaulay, pastor of the Prospect Presbyterian Church, in charge. Burial was in the Prospect Presbyterian Church cemetery.
